Boarding Kennels

When interviewing a prospective boarding facility, ask about dog management, safety policies and discuss how they may address your dog's specific needs. We encourage you to discuss at a minimum the following:

About the facility

1. Can you tour the facility with your dog?
2. Is someone on the property/in the building at all times 24/7?
3. Is the facility heated or air conditioned? Are the floors heated?
4. What are their pick up and drop off times?



About facility management

5. Can you bring your dog's toys, food and bedding?
 - A. Can you bring special bedding for an older dog?
 - B. If you have 2 dogs can they share the same kennel/run/room?
 - C. Can they administer necessary medication?
6. Do they offer playtimes with other dogs? What screening process is used to select which dogs play together?
7. Do they offer exercise times? Can you purchase extra exercise times?
8. Is their staff canine first aid certified?
9. Do they have professional insurance? Can they provide a copy?

Pet Sitters

Some dogs do not do well in the boarding environment and do much better when kept at home where routines can stay as close to normal as possible. In this case, a pet sitter may be just the service you - and your dog - are looking for. When selecting a pet sitter, you will find that services and fees will vary. We encourage you to discuss at a minimum the following:

1. Do they have professional insurance? Can they provide a copy?
2. Do they have references? Call them!
3. Availability for duration you will be away?
4. Rates, services and coverage area?
5. Can they visit before scheduled pet sitting dates to review:
 - a. Rules of the house: couch, bed, crates
 - b. Where food is kept: how to feed, how often and how much?
 - c. Dog waste clean-up procedures
6. Are they canine first aid certified?
7. Check with your veterinary staff to see if they are familiar with the pet sitter you are considering.
8. Advise the pet sitter of which veterinarian your dog's care is provided by as well as the closest emergency clinic preferred.
